

# Declaration of Independence of the States

## To Protect the Inalienable Rights of the People

Be it resolved and declared that:

*The GOD Who gave us life gave us inalienable Rights at the same time. That among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.*

*That the U.S. supreme court in an act of supreme arrogance and in defiance of the GOD Who gave us life, sought to deny PREBORN CHILDREN their inalienable Right to Life in 1973.*

*That the U.S. supreme court sought to do so by its own 'interpretation' of the U.S. Constitution and the Fourteenth Amendment, thereby teaching the people to break GOD's VI Commandment: "THOU SHALT NOT KILL".*

*That the Constitution of any nation may not be interpreted so as to cause the Ten Commandments and moral law of GOD to be broken, or to render 'legal' the breaking of such Commandments or moral law.*

*That morality comes from GOD and GOD Alone. GOD writes His Laws upon the human heart.*

*That no government or branch of government may be rightfully instituted among men to hand down morality, or to alter or delimit the moral law of GOD.*

*That a king does not hand down morality, but rather receives it from on High, like everyone else.*

*That a president does not hand down morality, but rather receives it from on High, like everyone else.*

*That a parliament, legislature or congress does not hand down morality, but receives it from on High, like everyone else.*

*That an intermediary court or supreme court of any nation does not hand down morality, but receives it from on High, like everyone else.*

*That in order to live in the hearts of men, the Constitution and laws of any nation must themselves be 'interpreted' so as to conform to the laws of Nature and Nature's GOD, and to uphold inalienable rights.*

*That the constitution of any nation may not be placed above the laws of Nature and Nature's GOD, nor may a Constitution be 'interpreted' so as to cause to be legal that which is an abomination to GOD and against the laws of Nature and Nature's GOD.*

*That the motto of the United States of America is: In GOD We Trust, appropriately inscribed upon the Nation's money. This is the GOD of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, spoken of by our forefathers in the Declaration of Independence which provides that "...all men are Created Equal, that they are endowed by their CREATOR with certain unalienable rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness."*

*That the U.S. supreme court may not take unto itself power to amend, alter or abridge inalienable rights.*

*That the Tenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution provides: "The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are RESERVED TO THE STATES RESPECTIVELY, or to the PEOPLE." Herein lies the power of the States to Protect inalienable rights, thereby strengthening the Union in the Nation's reverential respect for the God Who gave us life.*

*That any action by the U.S. supreme court in defiance of the GOD Who gave us life and in violation of the Tenth Amendment is void ab initio (void from the beginning) and may be declared null and void by such State or States desiring to do so under the authority of the 'Law above the law' and the Tenth Amendment to the United States Constitution.*

*That a State may invoke State Sovereignty to protect the inalienable rights of the people under the principle of "INTERPOSITION".*

*That a State may invoke State Sovereignty to protect GOD-given morality, and the health, safety and welfare of its citizens by acting on the authority of the 'Law above the law' under the principle "INTERPOSITION", pursuant to the Tenth Amendment to the United States Constitution.*
